We asked: What are the priorities in your neighbourhood?

You said: Underage drinking and anti-social behaviour in Whaley Bridge Town Centre on Friday evenings, especially around the Railway Car Park and Reservoir Road areas.

We did: Increased patrols and alcohol seized from underage drinkers.

Letters have been delivered to parents advising them of their youngster's behaviour. A joint initiative was carried out alongside British Transport Police where a passive drugs dog was used to give an indication of drug use. As a result several searches were made. The number of calls about anti-social behaviour has reduced.

You said: Anti-social behaviour and damage at Taxal Lodge.

We did: Increased patrols, youngsters moved on and letters delivered to parents about their behaviour. One person has been arrested for drugs offences. We have also held meetings with the local councils and Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Service to discuss ways to secure the derelict building and make the area safe.

Please contact us on the details below if you have any concerns or issues about your local community. In addition to quarterly meetings, we also hold monthly surgeries. These take place on the last Thursday of the month at the the Tesco store in Whaley Bridge, between 6 and 7pm. We look forward to meeting you.
