We asked: What are the priorities in your neighbourhood?

You said: Anti-social behaviour around the canal basin and on the towpath.

We did: Increased patrols, especially during the evenings on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, with positive action taken against any offenders. A 17 year old boy has been given a final warning for possession of a Class B drug. We have also been working with British Transport Police and will be carrying out joint patrols. A Boat Watch has been set up and our team have taken part in a community litter pick in the area, with another one set to take place in the future. We have noticed that reports have reduced recently, since the priority was first introduced but was decided at our last meeting in April to continue to target the area over the next few months

The priority will be reviewed again at our next meeting at 7pm on Wednesday, July 13 at The Mechanics Institute in Whaley Bridge. Please come along to find out more about more about this issue or if you would like to suggest future priorities for ourselves and our partnership organisations.
