

Whaley Bridge Memorial Park Calendar 2016

Photo competition general rules

- The competition is open to UK residents only.
- Entrants under the age of 18 years need to have a parent or guardian consent to enter.
- Photographs entered must be taken of Memorial Park or from within Memorial Park.
- Entrants can submit up to four landscape size photos in total, in colour or black and white.
- Entrants must include their name, address and contact telephone number (both daytime and evening). When emailing the image please save the file using your full name.
- Photos should be submitted in their original high resolution digital files. These files should be of sufficient quality to reproduce to the following specifications: 300 dpi, the landscapes images must have a minimum width of 3354 pixels x height 1736 pixels.
- A short caption for underneath the image is optional, up to 100 characters including spaces.
- Entries should be emailed to MemorialParkPhoto@highpeak.gov.uk
- The competition closes at midnight on Sunday 13 September 2015. Entries received after this date and time will not be considered.
- High Peak Borough Council cannot be responsible for any technical problems which may result in any entry being lost or delayed.
- High Peak Borough Council accepts no responsibility for entries which are lost or corrupted during upload.
- Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted and no feedback on any entry will be provided.
- Pictures must not have been published in any other calendar or similar publication.
- This competition is open to amateur photographers only. For the purposes of this competition, a professional photographer will be considered to be someone who makes more than half their annual income from the sale of their photographs.
- No wildlife habitats should be harmed or unduly disturbed in the process of taking photographs.
- High Peak Borough Council and its judges reserve the right to exclude any image they believe may have been excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.
- Full copyright title shall be retained by the Author of any submissions. By submitting any contribution to High Peak Borough Council, you agree to grant High Peak Borough Council a perpetual royalty free licence to use any or all of the contributions in any of their publications, on the website and/or in any promotional material. Permission will be sought and the author credited where possible.
- Any contribution must be your own original work; it must not infringe the rights of third parties including copyright, trade mark, trade secrets, privacy, publicity, personal or proprietary rights.
- If your contribution features other people who are recognisable, you are responsible for ensuring that you have their permission for the contribution to be treated according to the uses set out above. Contributions featuring children under 18 can only be accepted if you are the parent or guardian; by accepting these terms and conditions you warrant that you are the parent or guardian and that you grant permission for the contribution to be treated according to the uses set out above.
