### TOP TRAY COMPETITION CLASS RULES

1. The Top Tray Class is for a display of three types of vegetables from the following eight. The quantity of each vegetable required for the display is given.in brackets: Carrots (3) Cauliflower (2) Onions (3) Parsnips (3) Peas (6) Potatoes (3) Runner Beans (6) Tomatoes (6)

Each individual type of vegetable will be judged to a total of 20 points. This is split into three as follows: 7 points for size, shape and colour: 7 points for condition: 6 points for uniformity

All vegetables are to be displayed for effect.

2. The vegetables must be displayed within an area measuring 18" x 24" without bending any part of them. No part of any exhibit may exceed the size of the tray

A tray or board measuring 18"  $\times$  24" can be used to display the vegetables, or the area can simply be marked on the staging. Where a tray has a lip or edge, the internal measurements must not exceed 18"  $\times$  24"

3. A Black cloth is permitted and the tray may be painted. Parsley is permitted for garnishing, but no other foliage or accessories such as plates, sand, rings, etc. will be allowed. Onion tops may be tied or whipped using raffia.

Carrots and parsnips must have foliage trimmed back to 1" to 2" 'Peas and beans must be displayed with some stalk attached. Tomatoes must be displayed with calyces.
