In our 'Postcard from the Future Art Competition', Whaley Bridge children were invited to draw a vision of their town in 2032. Around 400 pupils from Whaley Bridge and Furness Vale Primary Schools, as well as Taxal and Fernilee C of E Primary School, and Bridgemont and Sunshine Nurseries submitted entries to the competition.
